Racine Kenosha Community Action Agency, Inc. (RKCAA) has successfully operated anti-poverty programming in Racine County since 1967 and in Kenosha County since 1978. The RKCAA Board of Directors comprises a three-part structure that includes representation from civic, low-income, and government sectors of Racine and Kenosha Counties.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

- Expanded access to fresh foods via food vouchers for WIC Families and Seniors.
- Managed COVID Relief dollars to provide rental/mortgage assistance and access to basic needs such as diapers and food.
- Delivered more than 3.1 million pounds of food to pantries, shelters, and meal sites.
- Promoted health and nutrition education with cooking demonstrations on YouTube.
- Secured nearly \$4M in Federal resources.

FINANCIALS

RKCAA receives federal, state, local, and private funding. In 2021, the agency managed twenty-seven programs totaling \$9.5 million in Racine and Kenosha counties. We aim to leverage government funding with local resources to address the most pressing needs in our communities.
